

Grow It Green is a full spice solution export company with extensive experience in the production and processing of capsicum (chilis, paprika, habanero) ginger and turmeric. It also offers fresh Asian vegetables like okra, to clients in Europe.

The company has an equipped dehydration and processing facility ensuring most of the work is done in-house. Their production capacity stems from nucleus farms and more than 2,250 outgrowers located across four regions who undergo continuous training and sensitization to meet strict food safety, quality assurance and operating standards.

Now, Grow It Green is one of the largest exporter of dried capsicum in Ghana. During the peak season they employ around 250 workers for its operations, 80% of whom are women. They recently obtained their GLOBALG.A.P. certification for its farm and currently finalizing their Fairtrade and organic certification, both as a producer and for farmers in their outgrower scheme.


