

Organic certification is deeply rooted in its identity, reflecting its commitment to environmental preservation and the well-being of workers and consumers. Its main products include acerola, passion fruit, cassava, and a range of medicinal and culinary herbs, all scalable according to demand. The farm also partners with certified processors, meeting international production standards, to produce frozen acerola and passion fruit pulp with full traceability.

Applying regenerative practices adapted to semi-arid conditions, Fazenda Bella prioritizes quality, while preserving nature, and contributing to the local livelihoods by generating income. It remains committed to soil health, biodiversity restoration, and delivering reliable certified organic ingredients to global partners.

Its processing facility handles 11t per day, using thermal sterilization, moisture reduction, magnetic filtration, and impurity ventilation, while upholding the highest standards of quality and safety. The company oversees every stage of production – from planting, cultivation, and harvesting to processing and extraction. It also produces the first guaraná-based energy drink ever registered in Brazil – reaffirming its pioneering trajectory and its commitment to quality, innovation, and authenticity.




