Cashew nut oil is cold-pressed from the valuable cashew nut. It contains vitamin E and unsaturated fatty acids in abundance, and can be used for making various cosmetic products. ESI mainly markets it as hair and body oil, but also started a successful local soap production. For the European market, ESI hopes to encourage the use of cashew nut oil as a cosmetic ingredient as well.

Taguatech is an Ecuadorian company dedicated to the production of plant-based white powder from the Tagua seed (vegetable ivory) that grows wild in the rainforests of Ecuador. It is used in cosmetic formulations to match or enhance the performance of synthetic ingredients.

Natural white tagua powder can be used as an exfoliant, sensory enhancer, whitening agent, smoothing agent, or as a natural substitute for PMMA, talc and titanium dioxide. Tagua powder is a non-perishable ingredient, suitable for scrubs, makeup, creams, and as a pigment carrier.



The use of natural white tagua powder supports the conservation of Ecuador's rainforests, where tagua palms grow wild, while improving the livelihoods of local communities through sustainable seed harvesting.

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
